As the new year begins, it is crucial to prioritise safety on the roads around the school. With children walking, riding bikes and being dropped off these areas become busy hubs. Please remember to:

- drive within the speed limits, look out for children and obey the rules of the school crossing and parking regulations
- Ensure children exit the car on the passenger, curb side of the car to avoid stepping into traffic
- Only park on the school grounds if you have a Government issued disability pass or a school issued pass.

Safe driving around schools is a collective responsibility that requires patience and vigilance.

Mobile phones

Mobile phones must be handed into the front office or the class teacher at the beginning of the day. Students can collect them at the end of the day. This is in line with the Government and School's policy on mobile phones. This policy can be accessed on the school website.

Fruit fly outbreak

Fruit fly has been detected in the Glynde area. There are no restrictions on including store bought fruit in school lunch boxes, in any area. However, there are restrictions on home-grown fruit. People living within a 15km radius of the detection site are affected, please check the fruit fly outbreak map to see if your home or school travel route is within this area.

Red Outbreak Zone: If you live here, keep all home-grown fruit at home. Do not take it to school or elsewhere.

Yellow Suspension Zone: You can move home-grown fruit within this zone but not into the red outbreak zone. These restrictions are in place until 16 April 2025.
