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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear Parents,

Save the date: We will be having a special End of Year Celebration Assembly on Thursday 12th December with the JP (Reception to year 2/3) from 9am-10am and the Primary (Year 3/4– Yr 6) from 11am—12. Each class will perform a short item during the assembly with the choir and school band performing. Student awards will be presented during the assembly. As space will be limited, only two family members can attend the assembly.



Music in 2025: As a school, we will be offering students a range of experiences with music continuing on from the programs offered this year. We will continue with our music lessons with Ms Bala for our junior primary students and have Instrumental Music, guitar and percussion for our students in Years 5 and 6. The Festival of Music Choir will also be run again next year for students in Years 5 and 6. Students in Years 5 and 6 must nominate to participate in the Choir and Instrumental Music classes and commit to continuing with the lessons once started.

As a reminder: As stated in the last newsletter, the assigning of students to their next class is a long and considered process with parents and students notified of 2025 class placements in the last week of term 4. If you have a something that you would like us to consider in this process, please put it in writing either via an email or letter addressed to the principal. Please remember that you cannot request a specific teacher or group of friends



for your child to be with. Information must be received by the end of week 3, term 4 to be considered.

STEM workshops: The afterschool STEM workshops with tutors from STEM Centre Australia have started and are well received by the students attending them. Students have spoken of the 'cool robots' that they have been using and programming during the

first lessons. These workshops continue over the term.

Pupil Free Day: <u>Friday 1st November is a Pupil Free Day</u>. Teachers will be engaged learning about and planning for embedding STEM learning in the class programs. Futures learning which anticipates and prepares for emerging trends and challenges, is greatly enhanced by embedding STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) education within programs. By integrating STEM principles, students develop critical thinking, problem-solving and technological skills essential for navigating the complexities of the future. This approach ensures learners are equipped with the knowledge and competencies necessary to innovate and excel in an increasingly digital and interconnected world.
